The Legislative Committee continues its work between legislative sessions. The party primary and runoffs are over, and we have our candidates locked in for the general election in November. The House of Medicine has been very successful in its influence and endorsements throughout this election cycle.

TSGE was represented during the recent TMA Advocacy Retreat preparing well ahead of next Session for the issues that may arise. We may rest assured that scope of practice will be front and center again. The TSGE remains committed to the proposition that the best way to deliver medical care is with a team approach with the physician as the lead. Other issues such as the expansion of Medicaid and ensuring there are reasonable limits to the corporate practice of Medicine are anticipated.

When issues critical to the practice of gastroenterology arose in the Legislature, we could contact our members and inform them so they could educate their representative. It is an attainable vision.
